<small>*GENERAL MEMBERSHIP - General Membership shall be open to all persons with three (3) years professional experience in an environmental discipline (e.g. project or task manager, etc., who exercises independent judgment in an interdisciplinary environmental field). <b>All General Members of the FAEP shall also be General members in good standing of the NAEP.</b> A General Member shall be considered a voting member of the Association, eligible to hold office or to be elected to the BOARD. *ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP - Associate membership is open to those who do not meet the General membership requirements and to other individuals who are interested in environmental issues, ideas or technology. A Florida Associate shall be considered a voting member of the FAEP, not eligible to hold an office, but eligible to be elected to the BOARD. This category is especially applicable to recently graduated students. *CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP - Group memberships are available to corporations, government agencies and/or other entities involved in and related to the environmental profession. Each group membership will be for a minimum of 5 qualified employees. Corporate membership level applies to FAEP membership dues, chapter membership dues apply for those joining local chapters.</small>
